


Easy Load Ramp and Tray Systems

Additional Instructions

Hitch Tite



HITCH TITE

The Hitch Tite is a device to stop the movement of the Easy Load Tray (ELT) Receiver Hitch Insert (RHI) in the receiver hitch of the transporting vehicle for your trike or handcycle. When inserted in the RHI it will snug the RHI against a sidewall of the transporting vehicle's receiver hitch.

The first thing to do is determine which hole in the RHI you are going to use to attach it to your transporting vehicle. Once you have accomplished this peel the protective layer of red plastic off the double sticky tape on the side of the Hitch Tite, insert it into the RHI at the selected hole, and push the double sticky tape against the sidewall of the RHI. Now, insert the bolt into the Hitch Tite, tighten it tight and then take it out. You have now secured the Hitch Tite to the RHI and you are ready to attach the ELT to the vehicle and take your trike to the nearest trail for a ride.

Once you have this installed with the bolt in place, if you purchased a lock set, take the bolt out of the installed Hitch Tite and install the lock set bolt and the key lock.

If you remove the ELT RHI from your vehicles receiver hitch, upon reinstalling be sure to put the Hitch Tite bolt in the same direction as originally installed, i.e., the Hitch Tite nut should be against a side of the receiver hitch so the bolt screws directly into the nut. If inserted in the direction away from the nut the Hitch Tite will become unusable.
